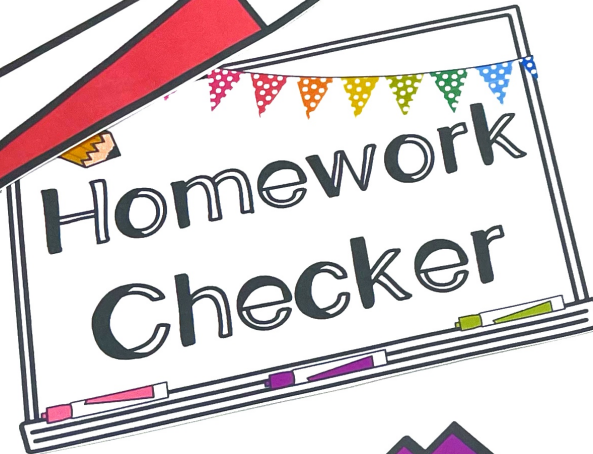
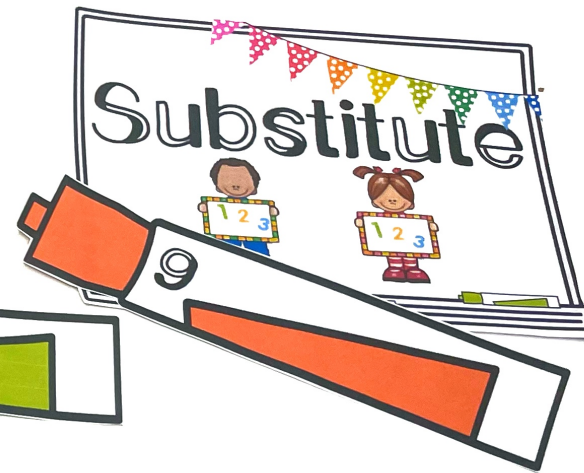

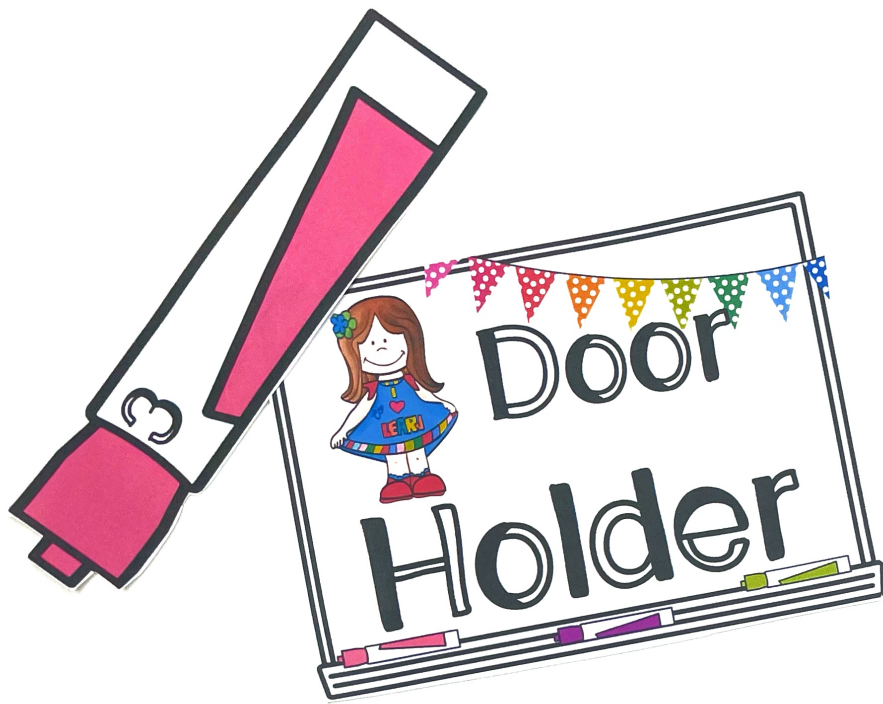

Why Use Classroom Jobs:

- Give students a purpose and sense of ownership in the classroom
- Students develop crucial social emotional skills
- Builds excitement about potentially boring classroom tasks

Tips for Use:

- Clearly model how to do each classroom job
- Use interactive modeling to teach and practice jobs
- Decide how long you want to keep the position: 1 week, 1 month, 1 quarter, etc.
- Have a student model a good example and a poor example of each job
- Be specific with praise for each position. This will help the other students in the future know what you like to see in specific jobs.
- Rotate students through jobs so every student has the opportunity to hold the position.
